What do you think about commuting?

Some of the responses:

"It's a gross necessary part of life"

"If is needed then it should be done"

"Commuting extended lengths (due to affordability or availability of housing) is extremely annoying. Commuting in general is not very annoying."

"I think there are two sides of one same coin. Commuting can be either a very enjoyable experience and an opportunity to clear your mind or a very stressful daily routine."


"Its all good till I get into traffic"

Conclusions:

There were a lot of comments about commuting being a necessary thing but not enjoyable because of traffic. Also there were some responses that went more to a positive comment as this time could be used for self reflection or establishing the separation between work and home. such as other answers that say they didn't mind to commute.

Do you enjoy commuting?

After the interviews I wanted to dig deeper on how joyful is this experience to the user and how much difference there is between the percentage that enjoy it vs the percentage that doesn't.



Conclusions:

There is a very small percentage difference between people who enjoy commuting and people that don't. So i want to understand what are users enjoying so there is a continuing on it and what they don't in order to make it better.

What method of transportation do you use? Why?

Here I wanted to understand what method is most commonly being used as it seems to provide more of a joyful experience than a negative experience.

Some of the responses:

"My car and Marta. My car is best to go out of the perimeter and day to day and I use Marta when I want to go to Downtown Atlanta because I hate parking there and driving there in the roads because they are tiny, have many potholes, and overall gross"

"I prefer public transportation, by car is typical - rather consistent. Public transport in my area is just extremely inconsistent and inconvenient, otherwise would be the priority."

"My car. Because it's the easiest one, I can move whenever I want and wherever I want"

"Car unfortunately"

"Car, because I don't live near the bus or train. Driving is faster too!"

"Metro. Don't need to worry about traffic and always on time"

Conclusions:

Even Though most of the responses said they used car, some of them highlighted how good public transport is but they couldn't use it because of accessibility issues or they did use it but as a support service for your car.

What do you do in your time commuting?

As I asked if people were enjoying commuting or not I wanted to know what they are doing in order to feel that way about the experience.

Some of the responses:

In the car, I love jamming to music or talking to family or friends on the phone.

Nothing, or listen to a podcast

Listening music, thinking about my projects.

Listen to podcasts

Podcast or Jam to some tunes to musician

I like to listen music or podcasts

Listen to music or call people.

Listen to music. Observe people to then animate them.

Listening to music and singing in the car. In public transport listening to music, chatting, reading, and etc.

Listen to music or podcasts

Listen to podcast or make phone calls

Enjoy music

Checking social media

I listen to the radio or sit in silence and look out the window

Listen to music or podcasts

Conclusions:

A lot of responses were related to doing hearing related activity. So How might we design the space of commuting enhance that listening experience?

Without thinking about traffic or time in general what is your least favorite part of commuting?

As there is also a downside to most of the things we enjoy i wanted to see what would users think about the downsides of commuting without thinking about time as a negative variable.

Some responses:

"If you have a long commute and you need to go to the bathroom it's a real inconvenience if you're driving."

"Trying to get my phone to play audio while trying to drive safely"

"Can't be productive during commuting"

"How my butt hurts from sitting too long, uncomfortable seats/ legroom"

"My least favorite part is that I get nervous every time I drive I could get into an accident"

"Maybe when there's too much people and you're uncomfortable, uncomfy seats too"

"Public transit - other people are weird."

"Insecurity and conglomerations"

"The impact on the environment, the cost and not being able to walk to locations like most big cities"

"Sharing with other people, and the unclean surfaces"

Conclusions:

There are a lot of comments that relate with insecurity and social interactions. But there are also comments about the lack of comfort and how it takes a lot from the joy of the experience.

What do you tend to take with you while commuting?(Ex: Handbags,More than one backpack)

To fully understand the users' needs I wanted to make sure I knew what they were carrying because they would have to adjust to the space in the vehicle with whatever they carry.
